Frank Musiek, Ph.D.

Frank E. Musiek, is Professor and Director of Auditory Research, Dept. of Communications Sciences and Professor of Otolaryngology, School of Medicine, University of Connecticut. He is the 2007 AAA Recipient of the James Jerger Career Award for Research in Audiology, the 2010 recipient of “The Honors of The American Speech, Language and Hearing Assn.”, and Recipient of “Book of the Year Award” for Handbook of Central Processing Disorder Vol. I and II (with Gail Chermak co editor) 2007. He has published over 175 articles and book chapters in the areas of auditory evoked potentials, central auditory disorders and auditory neuroanatomy.

Patricia B. Kricos, PhD

Dr. Patricia Kricos, Professor of Audiology, University of Florida, received her PhD degree from the Ohio State University (1973). Her major clinical and research interests are in audiologic rehabilitation with adults. Dr. Kricos is currently serving as Past-President on the American Academy of Audiology Board of Directors, and as Ex Officio of the American Academy of Audiology Foundation. She also serves on the Advisory Council of the Better Hearing Institute and the Ida Institute, and as a Professional Advisor for the Hearing Loss Association of Florida Board of Trustees.

Ryan McCreery, PhD

Ryan McCreery, Ph.D. is a Research Associate at Boys Town National Research Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska. His research in the Hearing and Amplification Research Laboratory and Audibility, Perception and Cognition Laboratory focuses on improving audibility-based predictions of speech recognition in children with normal hearing and children with hearing loss who use hearing aids. He is a collaborator with multiple researchers at Boys Town, including projects related to loudness perception with hearing aid users, classroom listening and learning, and audio-visual speech perception.

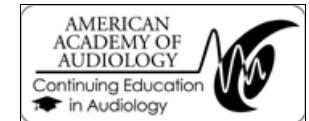
